#### Day 1- Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> November

Depart Melbourne Tullamarine on Cathay Pacific Flight CX 134 and arrive in Hong Kong at 3.05pm

We will be transferred to The Kimberly Hotel.

For those that want to hit the ground running - Temple Street Night Markets open from 4.00pm and are within walking distance of the Kimberley Hotel.

#### Day 2 – Friday 5<sup>th</sup> November

Breakfast and early departure for China

**Shenzhen:** Our shopping in Shenzhen will be done in one building “Lowe Commercial City”. It has five floors and thousands of shops. The shops are all numbered. Please shop in pairs or with other members of the group. A meeting point will be arranged every 2 hours.

**What to pay:** The general rule is one third of the offered price. Do not start bargaining unless you intend on buying. The most effective way is to say “too much” and walk away, majority of the time your price will be accepted. If not, try the shop next door.

#### Day 3-Saturday 6<sup>th</sup> November

##### Jade Market, Stanley Markets & Peak Tram (including 4 Course Dinner)

Jade Market: At this market is you will find every type of jewellery imaginable. With over 400 stalls the choice is never ending. They offer everything from Jade Carvings to inexpensive trinkets. The vendors will design your pieces as you wait. They will shorten or lengthen and add any bead for you.

### **Stanley Markets:**

A little more “up market” than most other street markets in Hong Kong and not as much opportunity to “bargain” but this day market is on most visitors’ list of “must do”. The market runs along narrow congested alleyways and comprises shops fronted by stalls offering a variety of clothes, footwear, sportswear, paintings and artwork, toys and souvenirs.

The market has the advantage of being located close to other attractions. Stanley waterfront and boardwalk, Murray House, Stanley Plaza, Stanley Main Beach, St Stephens Beach and Stanley Military Cemetery are all within a short walking distance.

To get to there we'll grab a taxi –approx 4 in each cab HK100.00 SO 4.00AUD each for a lovely scenic drive down to the Bayside.

Tonight we'll head up to THE PEAK where we will enjoy a beautiful 4 Course Dinner. THE PEAK TRAM is pulled by steel cables and climbs 373 metres (around 1200 feet)

### **Day 4 – Sunday 07 November**

#### **Day of Leisure**

Today is the day to do that last minute bargain hunting or collect all your tailoring and other pre-ordered purchases. For those that have had enough of shopping and would like to take a different look at Hong Kong we can arrange a ½ day Island Tour and/or a Sampan Cruise on the busy Hong Kong Harbour.
