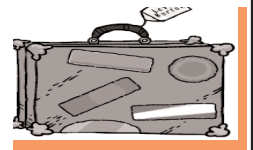

+++ If you want to get fit in a hurry, head for The Rock near Wagga Wagga.

A small group from Hay spent the weekend at The Rock to prepare for Kokoda and we were not disappointed. It is a good climb to the top and the six-kilometre walk/climb is graded 'difficult' and expected to take three hours to complete.

After a trial run in scorching heat on Saturday afternoon, we did it twice on Sunday in less than five hours with a good lunch break in between. Camping is not allowed on the reserve, so we headed for the local football grounds which had a welcoming sign 'public toilets'. Great spot, but beware of sprinklers that are timed to come on at 3.15am – the spray went straight through my swag.

+++ The archipelago of the Maldives has come up with an innovative new approach to tackling climate change and rising sea waters - build an island that floats.

None of the 1200 islands which make up the Maldives are higher than six-feet above sea level, which means that rising oceans are a serious concern, and if the current levels of growth are not curtailed, the entire archipelago could be wiped out.

So in an innovative new move, the government has approved the creation of mini-floating islands.

The Maldives government is pulling out all the stops in the fight against climate change.

Not only has the entire country gone carbon neutral, educated all of their children in environmental science and furiously built retaining walls around every island, the government is also buying up land in nearby nations as a place to retreat to when the Maldives disappears.

The Maldives plans to seek the assistance of Dutch Docklands to also develop floating housing units in the Maldives in the future.
