Registrations are now accepted for the opening of the Booroorban time capsule on Easter Saturday, April 3.

The day will also include a school reunion, historic walk, cricket match and old fashioned games and a dinner in the evening.

Items in the capsule, put down 25 years ago, will be on display in the Booroorban Hall for everyone to see.

The capsule will be released at 5.30pm with the children of Booroorban taking part in the rededication.

It will be opened in 2035.

Another highlight of the day is the school reunion, with an official photograph to be taken of all ex-students who attend.

A total of 114 students attended the school between 1961 and 1981.

The historic walk will be launched in the school grounds as part of the festivities and will be further developed over the next 12 months.

Queen Mary 2, the largest and most famous cruise ship ever to visit Australia, will make a world-first circumnavigation of the country, visiting five states and the Northern Territory.

Capable of carrying 2620 guests and more than 1,200 crew, it has 10 restaurants, five pools, largest ballroom at sea, largest library at sea and the world's first floating planetarium.

Queen Mary 2 will sail from Cape Town to Sydney via Fremantle and Adelaide and stop at eight Australian ports, including Sydney, Fremantle, Adelaide and the Whitsundays as well as maiden visits to Cairns (Yorkeys Knob), Darwin, Melbourne and Brisbane.

Her circumnavigation will also include a call at Bali.

Australians will be able to choose from three circumnavigation options starting in February: a 22-night voyage departing Sydney, a 20-night voyage from Fremantle and a 21-night voyage departing Adelaide.

Tickets go on sale mid-year and I will keep you posted.
